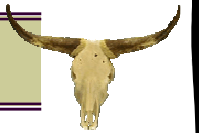

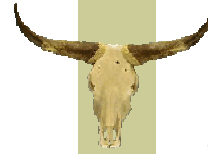
Beef Production Systems on Western Rangelands
